1. **ENTRIES OPEN: 9:00am 9 March 2026**
2. **ENTRIES CLOSE: 5:00pm Wednesday, 6 May 2026**
3. All entry forms (and payments) **MUST** be received by **5:00pm Wednesday, 6 May 2026**.
****NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED – NO EXCEPTIONS****
4. **ENTRY FEES:** \$10 entry fee per item - Painting Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5; Photography Sections 6 & 7
5. All entries must be received **ONLINE** or by **EMAIL** to artshow@currabubulaartshow.com.au.
 - If this is not possible, please contact the Event Coordinator for assistance.
 - Check that you have entered all relevant information on the Entry form
 - Entries received are binding. The catalogue information will be taken only from the **Entry Form**.
6. All entries are to be showing for the first time.
7. Paintings **WILL BE REJECTED** if:
 - a. Entered in more than one section
 - b. Oversized paintings (over 1.2m x 1.2m) will **NOT** be accepted.
8. The title or price cannot be altered once submitted.
9. "Untitled" items are unable to go into the catalogue or be displayed.
10. The Australian Red Cross Commission of 25% should be included in your pricing.
11. Net payment(s) will be made for sold paintings by **30 June 2026**.

TRANSPORT / DELIVERY / COLLECTION

14. The exhibitors must meet ALL transport and insurance costs to/from and during the Exhibition.
15. ALL care will be taken, but the Australian Red Cross, Currabubula Branch, will not accept liability for loss or damage in transit or while on exhibit.
16. ALL work must be securely packaged using bubble wrap or corflute cardboard.
17. **MUST BE NOTED ON ENTRY FORM**
 - a. If couriers or buses are used to convey artwork or photography to depots, please note that depots are not responsible for organising the return with couriers.
 - b. **A transport fee of \$10** must be included with your entry form for the return of each painting transported to and from Currabubula and the depot.

PAINTING Entry conditions, requirements & sizes

1. **THEME:** Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 are open **"Any Subject"**
2. **OPTIONAL THEME: All Painting Sections Prize** 'Life on the Land' – "Galla" Prize \$1,000
In memory of pioneers and sisters Margaret & Helen Scott and their farm "Galla". To be eligible for this prize, your painting should encapsulate 'Life on the Land.'
3. **SIZE LIMITS:**
 - Section 1, 2 3 & 5: Maximum size 1.2m² excluding frame. Limit of five paintings per section (one only, maximum size).
 - Section 4: **MINIATURE:** Maximum size 40cm perimeter excluding frame. The frame should be proportionate to the image and not exceed a perimeter of 122cm. Limit of five paintings.

4. **LOCAL ARTIST:** Artists residing within the following postcode areas: 2353, 2338, 2339, 2340, 2341, 2342, 2343, 2344, 2345, 2346, 2352, 2355, 2380 and 2381.
 5. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE FOR SALE**, and details must be clearly labelled on the back with the artist's name, address, title of work, section, medium used, and price.
Please download labels and attach them to the back of each painting submitted.
 6. Each entry must be the original work of the artist, suitably framed or mounted.
 7. All entries must be ready to hang with hanging wire attached and loose enough to avoid damage while hanging.
 8. All accepted entries are eligible for the Champion Prize.
 9. Catalogue Entries will be hung. However, the Organisers reserve the right to reject any painting deemed unsuitable for hanging.
 10. The Organisers reserve the right to have any entries reproduced in the Media. The Artist is responsible for ensuring that no relevant copyright laws are infringed.
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PHOTOGRAPHY Entry conditions, requirements, & sizes

1. **THEME:** Photography Sections 6 is **open**
 2. **THEME:** Photography Section 7 theme is **"Rural Landscape"**
 3. **SIZE LIMIT:** Prints must measure 8" x 12" inches. UNFRAMED and mounted on matt board measuring 12" x 16" (Limit of five photographs/prints per section).
 4. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE FOR SALE**, and details must be clearly labelled on the back with the photographer's name, address, title of work, section, and price.
Please download labels and attach them to the back of each photograph submitted.
 5. Each entry must be the photographer's original work.
 6. All accepted entries for Section 6 or 7 are eligible for that section's prize.
 7. Catalogue Entries will be hung; however, the Organisers reserve the right to reject any photograph deemed unsuitable for hanging.
 8. The Organisers reserve the right to have any entries reproduced in the Media. The Photographer is responsible for ensuring that no relevant copyright laws are infringed.
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PRE-LOVED ARTWORKS Sale conditions & requirements

If a once-loved piece no longer fits your space or style, why not give it a new home?

1. All items must be for sale, and details must be clearly labelled on the back with the artist's name, address, title of work, section, medium used, and price.
Please download labels and attach them to the back of each artwork submitted.
 2. Must be a painting, not a print, in good pre-loved condition
 3. All entries must be ready to hang with hanging wire attached and loose enough to avoid damage while hanging.
 4. All entries must be for sale of \$50 or more.
 5. All submissions must be available for sale, with a 25% commission payable on each sale
 6. All Entries will be listed in the catalogue for sale. However, the Organisers reserve the right to reject any painting deemed unsuitable for hanging.
 7. All exhibits are to be delivered to the Event Coordinator:

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HAND-MADE JEWELLERY Entry conditions & requirements

Collections of no more than 20 pieces - earrings are considered one piece

1. All items must be for sale, and details are to be printed clearly on white tags:
Artist's initials, item number, and item price. E.g., SP #1 \$59, SP #2 \$120, SP #3 \$60 etc.
2. A complete list of entries is to be entered online or provided by email.
3. Each entry must be an original creation and predominantly the handcrafted work of the exhibitor.
4. All exhibits are to be delivered to the coordinator.
